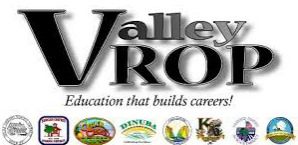

OHS Student Awarded Valley ROP Ambassador Award!



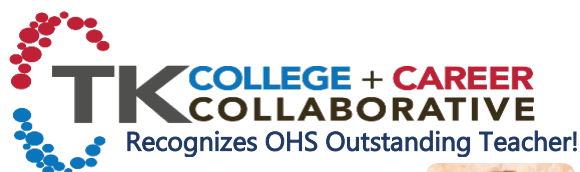

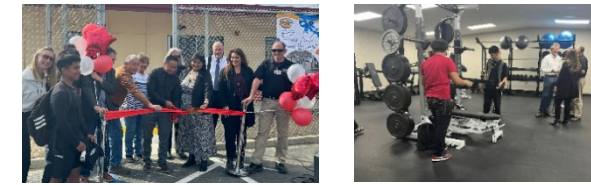

ELOP BRINGS A NEW YOUTH FITNESS CENTER FOR STUDENTS K-8

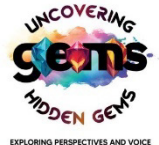

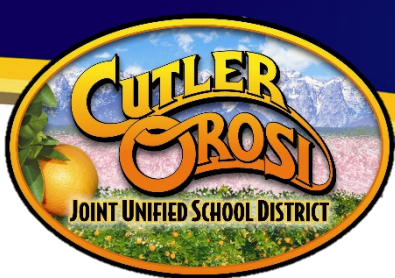
